

OVERVIEW OF ORAL TEST AT A2 LEVEL

Part	Task type	Assessment criteria	Language competencies
Oral 20 marks	Short conversation with the examiner: the candidate introduces himself/herself, then answers questions on their age, the weather, subjects studied, candidate's family, etc.	Assessed by two examiners, on the basis of assessment criteria that focus on candidate's ability to understand the examiner and respond appropriately using short utterances/responses. Some hesitation, lack of fluency and L1 interference in pronunciation acceptable	The candidate demonstrates a basic ability to communicate in everyday situations

Time allowed: 5 – 8 minutes
