Part	Task type	Assessment criteria	Language competencies
<p>Oral</p> <p>30 marks</p>	<p>Warm-up: (1-2 mins): candidate introduces him/herself; answers very general questions relating to their studies, the weather, etc.</p> <p>Part 1: Candidate indicates how he/she would react to 2 everyday situations given by the examiner in Polish.</p> <p>Part 2: Candidate talks about a picture/illustration provided by the examiner.</p> <p>Part 3: Discussion with the examiner on one or more of the following topics: hobbies, everyday life, university life, work, travel, their family, holidays, books, films, etc.</p>	<p>Candidates assessed by two examiners who judge communicative and interactional performance on basis of scoring criteria that focus on the following: Candidate's ability to understand and respond appropriately to examiner's questions, using a limited range of grammar and vocabulary accurately with intelligible pronunciation</p>	<p>Candidates are familiar with colloquial language and formulaic utterances necessary for everyday communication. Candidates are able to interact successfully and participate in conversations on familiar, everyday topics, and are able to describe situations and events and their own experiences.</p>
