Part	Task type	Assessment criteria	Language competencies
<p>Oral</p> <p>40 points</p>	<p>Warm-up: not assessed (2 mins): candidate introduces him/herself; answers very general questions relating to their studies, etc.</p> <p>Assessed part of the test:: (about 10-12 mins)</p> <p>a) Long turn based on a slogan drawn at the start of the task. Candidate is given 2-3 mins to think about what to say and then is asked to make a short (2-3 minute) presentation based on the slogan, commenting on it.</p> <p>b) The examiner may probe the topic presented by the student asking for further comment or clarification. He/she will then widen the discussion to topics of a more general nature. (5 – 6 minutes).</p>	<p>Candidates assessed by two examiners on basis of the following scoring criteria:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - pronunciation - fluency - grammatical accuracy - lexical & stylistic appropriacy - interactional competence 	<p>a) Fluent and accurate communication in all types of situations</p> <p>b) Appropriate and wide-ranging use of lexis</p> <p>c) Excellent interactional skills</p> <p>d) Able to discuss a very wide range of topics using suitable register for the situation</p>
