Oral 40 points	Warm-up: not assessed (2 mins): candidate introduces him/herself; answers very general questions relating to their studies, etc. Assessed part of the test:: (about 10-12 mins) a) Long turn based on a slogan drawn at the start of the task. Candidate is given 2-3 mins to think about what to say and then is asked to make a short (2-3 minute) presentation based on the slogan, commenting on it. b) The examiner may probe the topic presented by the student asking for further comment or clarification. He/she will then widen the discussion to topics of a more general nature. (5 – 6 minutes).
